Administrative Order
No. 2022 - 96

Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative supervision over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

It has come to the Court's attention that the Salome Justice Court will be without a justice of the peace beginning on September 1, 2022.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that effective September 1, 2022, administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Salome Justice Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Jessica Quickle, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in La Paz County, and Judge Quickle shall assign judicial officers as needed to conduct the court business. Judge Quickle is also authorized to issue such orders as necessary for the court to operate properly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until either a successor assumes duties as Justice of the Peace of the Salome Justice Court or the court ceases to exist as a result of the consolidation of the justice precincts in La Paz County as approved by its Board of Supervisors. Any cost associated with operating this court, including cost for judicial officers, shall be a county cost.
