This Court entered Administrative Order No. 2021-50 on April 14, 2021 and established a remote civil jury trial pilot court in the Superior Court in Mohave County. The Order directed the Superior Court in Mohave County to report its findings to the Arizona Judicial Council (AJC) by October 2022. The pilot project was set to conclude on December 31, 2022 but was extended until June 30, 2023 pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2022-95.

The Presiding Judge of Mohave County Superior Court has requested the Court to further extend the time for filing their findings. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the remote civil jury trial pilot project is extended through July 31, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Mohave County Superior Court shall file its findings to the AJC in June 2023.
