In light of the recent citation charging Justice of the Peace Juan Guerrero and, in the interest of justice and to maintain public confidence in the justice system, it is appropriate to re-assign the judge to non-judicial duties.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3 of the Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Justice of the Peace Juan Guerrero is reassigned from his duties at the South County Justice Court in Yuma County to such non-judicial duties as assigned to him by the Honorable David Haws, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Yuma County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective April 27, 2023, administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the South County Justice Court shall be assumed by Judge Haws, and he shall assign judicial officers as needed to conduct court business. Judge Haws is also authorized to issue such orders as necessary for the court to operate properly. Any cost associated with operating this court, including cost for judicial officers, shall be a county cost.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall continue until further order of the Court.
