Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative supervision over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

It has come to the Court’s attention that the Sedona Municipal Court will be without a presiding magistrate beginning July 17, 2025. A successor has not yet been appointed by the Sedona City Council.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Sedona Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Ted Reed, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Coconino County, and Judge Reed shall assign judicial officers as needed to conduct the court business. Judge Reed is also authorized to issue such orders as necessary for the court to operate properly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties as presiding judge of the Sedona Municipal Court. Any cost associated with operating this court, including cost for judicial officers, shall be a municipal cost.
