In accordance with the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration § 1-104, the Chief Justice may establish standing committees to the Arizona Judicial Council to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities.

Under the authority granted to the Chief Justice by the Arizona Constitution, Article VI, Section 3, the Arizona Judicial Branch 2025 Strategic Agenda Awards Selection Committee is established. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Arizona Judicial Branch 2025 Strategic Agenda Awards shall be presented to individuals, groups, or courts that have made substantial contributions in the following categories: Expanding and Promoting Access to Justice; Maintaining Public Trust and Confidence; Protecting Children, Families, and Communities; Advancing Judicial Branch Excellence and Innovation; Enhancing Professionalism and Leadership within our Justice System; and Advancements in Technology. The awards shall be presented at the annual Court Leadership Conference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following individuals are appointed to the Arizona Judicial Branch 2025 Strategic Agenda Awards Selection Committee for the express purpose of considering 2025 Strategic Agenda Awards nominations. Committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the Chief Justice. The appointed members shall make award recommendations to the Arizona Supreme Court and shall hold their appointed position beginning upon signature of this Order and expiring on October 31, 2025.
