On January 8, 2025, this Court issued Administrative Order No. 2025-10, adopting certain amendments to the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration (ACJA) § 1-901 to exclude consent decrees from e-filing eligibility in the Superior Court in Pima County until January 3, 2026, due to technology constraints relating to the replacement of the court’s electronic document management system.

The replacement project has incurred delays, and the Superior Court in Pima County has requested that the exception in ACJA § 1-901 for e-filing consent decrees in Pima County be extended until its electronic document management system project is complete.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED extending the expiration date of the amendments to ACJA § 1-901 as adopted in Administrative Order No. 2025-10 to July 1, 2026. All other provisions of § 1-901 remain unchanged and in effect.
