Administrative Order

A.R.S. § 12-251(C) provides, "Probation department personnel shall qualify under minimum standards of experience and education established by the Supreme Court. Such standards may differ for counties of less than three hundred thousand persons from counties with three hundred thousand persons or more." ACJA § 6-106(F)(3), Personnel Practices, states that probation officers "shall be a United States citizen or have legal resident status and possess the following: a. At minimum, a bachelor's degree with a preference in the behavioral sciences or a related field from an accredited college or university; and b. Minimum age of 21 years."

The Criminal Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Yavapai County has requested a waiver of this requirement pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-251(C). The waiver will permit the Yavapai County Probation Department to hire the following probation officer applicant to the position of probation officer: Kaleigh Quinn.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that a waiver of ACJA § 6-106(F)(3) is granted allowing the Yavapai County Adult Probation Department to appoint Kaleigh Quinn to the position of probation officer.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this waiver is effective on and after the date of signature.
