Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative supervision over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

It has come to the Court’s attention that the Marana Municipal Court is without a presiding magistrate beginning April 16, 2025. A successor has been appointed by the Marana City Council to begin on May 5, 2025.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Marana Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Danelle B. Liwski, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Pima County, and Judge Liwski shall assign judicial officers as needed to conduct the court business. Judge Liwski is also authorized to issue such orders as necessary for the court to operate properly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties as presiding judge of the Marana Municipal Court. Any cost associated with operating this court, including cost for judicial officers, shall be a municipal cost.
