In furtherance of this Court’s goal of expanding access to justice, the Court adopted Administrative Order No. 2025-25 establishing the Government Law Admission Program (GLAP) in an effort to increase the number of lawyers serving the public in government law offices. It has come to this Court’s attention that modification of one of the application requirements is appropriate.

Therefore, pursuant to Article 6, Section 3, Constitution of Arizona, and for good cause shown and in the furtherance of justice,

IT IS ORDERED amending Administrative Order No. 2025-25, paragraph 6(c), as follows:

c. an avowal by the elected or appointed head of a government law office or their designee that, if licensed, the lawyer is or will be employed by the government law office;

All other provisions of Administrative Order No. 2025-25 remain unchanged and in effect.
