A.R.S. § 12-251(C) provides, "Probation department personnel shall qualify under minimum standards of experience and education established by the Supreme Court. Such standards may differ for counties of less than three hundred thousand persons from counties with three hundred thousand persons or more." ACJA § 6-106(F)(3)(a), Personnel Practices, states that probation officers must possess "[a]t minimum, a bachelor's degree with a preference in the behavior sciences or a related field from an accredited college or university."

The Acting Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in La Paz County has requested a waiver of this requirement pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-251(C). The waiver will permit the La Paz County Probation Department to appoint the following applicant to the position of probation officer: Robert Brady.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that a waiver of ACJA § 6-106(F)(3)(a) is granted regarding the educational requirements allowing the La Paz County Adult Probation Department to appoint Robert Brady to the position of probation officer.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this waiver is effective on and after the date of signature.
