Pursuant to the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration (ACJA) § 1-201(E), the Chief Justice may adopt technical changes in existing administrative code sections by administrative order without prior distribution for comment and action by the Arizona Judicial Council.

ACJA § 7-201 was recently amended and completely restyled. On March 12, 2026, the Arizona Judicial Council approved and recommended the revisions for adoption. On March 18, 2026, this Court adopted the revisions through Administrative Order No. 2026-30, with an effective date of July 1, 2026.

However, it is now necessary to extend the effective date of ACJA § 7-201 from July 1, 2026 to November 15, 2026. This extended date will correspond with the effective date of the conforming amendments to the remaining code sections under the Certification and Licensing Program.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the changes to ACJA § 7-201 adopted under Administrative Order No. 2026-30 are effective November 15, 2026.
