PRO TEMPORE ORDER  
No. 2021 - 38

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Yuma County has requested the appointment of a judge pro tempore to serve in that court for the purpose of enhancing the court's ability to process cases. Therefore, pursuant to Ariz. Const. Art. VI, § 31 and A.R.S. § 12-141 et seq.,

IT IS ORDERED that Pamela Walsma, State Bar #013112, is appointed as a judge pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Yuma County for a term beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointee shall perform judicial duties authorized by A.R.S. § 12-144 as assigned by the presiding judge. This appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Yuma County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the Superior Court in Yuma County obtaining appropriate funding from whatever source for any compensation due to said appointee pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and A.R.S. § 12-143 for service as a judge pro tempore.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointee may perform duties of a judge authorized by A.R.S. § 25-121 et seq. and A.R.S. § 12-2222 without specific assignment by the presiding judge subject to agreement by the appointee to perform these duties without public compensation or benefits.
