PRO TEMPORE ORDER  
No. 2023 - 48

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Yuma County has requested the appointment of a judge pro tempore to assist that court with the processing of cases. Therefore, pursuant to Ariz. Const. Art. VI, § 31 and A.R.S. § 12-141 et seq.,

IT IS ORDERED that Jerry Landau, Bar #004227, is appointed as a judge pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Yuma County for a term beginning upon signature of this Order, and ending June 30, 2024.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointee shall perform judicial duties authorized by A.R.S. § 12-144 as assigned by the presiding judge. This appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Yuma County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the Superior Court in Yuma County obtaining appropriate funding from whatever source for any compensation due to said appointee for service as a judge pro tempore pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and A.R.S. § 12-143, including the state's portion of their salary. The Superior Court in Yuma County and the appointee shall memorialize their agreement in writing as to the salary for services provided under this appointment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointee may perform duties of a judge authorized by A.R.S. § 25-121 et seq. and A.R.S. § 12-2222 without specific assignment by the presiding judge subject to agreement by the appointee to perform these duties without public compensation or benefits.
