The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Pima County has requested the appointment of court commissioners to serve as judges pro tempore to assist that court with the processing of cases. Therefore, pursuant to Ariz. Const. Art. VI, § 31 and A.R.S. § 12-141 et seq.,

IT IS ORDERED that the following individuals are appointed as judges pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Pima County for a term beginning October 15, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointees shall perform judicial duties authorized by A.R.S. § 12-144 as assigned by the presiding judge. These appointments are conditioned upon the approval of the Pima County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the agreement by the appointees to serve without compensation or benefits, other than that to which they are entitled as Superior Court Commissioners, as provided in A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and A.R.S. § 12-143 for service as judges pro tempore.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointees may perform duties of a judge authorized by A.R.S. § 25-121 et seq. and A.R.S. § 12-2222 without specific assignment by the presiding judge and subject to agreement by the appointees to perform these duties without public compensation or benefits.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the limits on compensation concerning the appointment of Soo Chang Conatser and Luke Brown in Pro Tempore Orders 2025-35 and 2025-36 are superseded by this Order beginning October 15, 2025, with all other provisions to remain in effect to the extent they do not conflict with this Order.
