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Overview:

The information is used to compile data at a statewide level for distribution to Arizona Adult Probation Departments, the Administrative Office of the Courts, the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, and posting on the Arizona Supreme Court website. The reports are to include statistical information gathered from the first through the last day of the month immediately preceding the due date.

Definitions:

DIRECT SUPERVISION - The number of clients sentenced in a Superior Court or Limited Jurisdiction Court residing in your County for whom you are providing direct supervision.

INDIRECT SUPERVISION - The number of clients sentenced in a Superior Court or Limited Jurisdiction Court. These clients are under supervision, but do not physically reside in your County.

ADMINISTRATIVE SUPERVISION - The number of Standards, IPS, or Unsupervised clients sentenced in a Superior Court for whom Direct or Indirect Supervision is not provided, yet require some case management activity. This includes § 13-3601.01 cases sentenced in a Limited Jurisdiction Court.

ABSOLUTE EXIT CATEGORIES—**Absolute Exit is defined as a client who is exiting probation, all cases and counts will be closed. A hierarchy is listed below, in order of precedence, if multiple exit types exist for a single client.**

- **Revoked to DOC:** The number of clients revoked and sentenced to the Department of Corrections this month.
- **Revoked to Jail:** The number of clients revoked and sentenced to County jail this month.
- **Revoked:** The number of clients revoked from probation this month, with no incarceration; may or may not include a fine.
- **Co-Terminus:** The number of clients whose probation term expires when their jail term expires.
- **Early Termination:** The number of clients discharged this month prior to completing their full court-ordered term of probation.
- **Earned Time Credit (ETC):** The number of clients discharged this month as a result of having their period of probation adjusted after being awarded earned time credit, in accordance with A.R.S. 13-924.
- **Full Termination:** The number of clients completing their full court-ordered term of probation this month.

- **Judicial Termination:** The number of clients discharged from probation this month by the Court for reasons not already listed.
- **Deceased:** The number of deceased clients terminated from probation this month.
- **Inter State Compact (Incoming) Closed Interest:** The number of incoming interstate compact clients who returned to the originating state and are no longer being supervised in Arizona.
- **Quashed/Purged Warrant:** The number of clients who were discharged from probation this month as a result of having their outstanding petition to revoke with warrant quashed or purged, thus causing the probation term to expire.

OTHER EXIT CATEGORY is defined as a client exiting their current supervision level to another level of supervision.

- **Modified/Reinstated to Unsupervised:** The number of clients modified/reinstated to Unsupervised Probation this month.
- **Modified to Intensive Probation Supervision:** The number of clients modified to IPS this month.
- **Reinstated to Intensive Probation Supervision:** The number of clients reinstated to IPS this month.
- **Modified/Reinstated to Standard:** The number of clients modified/reinstated to Standard Probation this month.
- **Modified/Reinstated to Standard Probation:** The number of clients modified/reinstated to Standard Probation this month.

PETITIONS FOR REVOCATION BY CLIENT

Track only petitions filed in a Court in your County, regardless of the client's physical location. Include petitions filed on absconders. If more than one petition is filed on a client at the same time, record only one petition according to the following descending order:

- **New Crime + Technical Violation:** The number of clients whose petition(s) contained allegations of **both** one or more new criminal offense(s) and one or more technical violation(s).
- **New Crime Only:** The number of clients whose petition(s) contained only allegations of one or more new criminal offense(s).
- **Technical Violation Only:** The number of clients whose petition(s) contained only allegations of one or more technical violation(s).

NEW CRIME CONVICTIONS BY CLIENTS—is defined as a client receiving a sentence for a crime committed after the earliest sentence date with an open probation grant. The crime must have occurred after the earliest probation start date. If more than one conviction applies per client at the same time, record only one conviction according to the following descending order:

- **New felony conviction:** The number of clients who were **sentenced** for a new felony offense this month.
- **New misdemeanor conviction:** The number of clients who were **sentenced** for a new misdemeanor offense, either in Superior Court or a Limited Jurisdiction Court, this month.

DISPOSITIONS BY CLIENT—a disposition is defined as the outcome of a petition to revoke or petition to modify probation.

If more than one disposition applies per client at the same time, record only one disposition according to the following descending order:

- **Revoked to DOC:** The number of clients revoked and sentenced to the Department of Corrections.
- **Revoked to Jail:** The number of clients revoked and sentenced to County jail.
- **Revoked:** The number of clients revoked from probation, with no incarceration; may or may not include a fine.
- **Co-Terminus:** The number of clients whose probation term expires when their jail term expires.
- **Reinstated to Intensive Probation:** The number of clients reinstated to Intensive Probation.
- **Reinstated to Standard Probation:** The number of clients reinstated to Standard Probation.
- **Reinstated to Unsupervised Probation:** The number of clients reinstated to Unsupervised Probation.
- **Dismissed/Withdrawn:** The number of clients whose petition to revoke was either dismissed or withdrawn.

COMMUNITY RESTITUTION—the total number of hours worked without compensation as an intermediate sanction, court ordered condition of probation or at the discretion of the supervising officer during the month, report the total hours reported.

- **Court Ordered Total Hours Reported:** The number of community restitution hours reported this month. Include only court-ordered community restitution hours. Any community restitution hours required by the probation officer for the purposes of an intermediate sanction shall not be included.
- **Discretionary Hours Reported:** The number of community restitution hours reported at the discretion of the probation officer. This will be derived from entries in the “Agency Assignment” screen utilizing the “Discretionary Community Restitution” feature.
- **Sanction Hours Reported:** The number of community restitution hours reported as a sanction during the reporting month. This will be derived from entries in the “Community Restitution Sanctions” screen.

TREATMENT—is defined as services provided to clients as part of their probation grant. Includes substance, mental health, sex offender, anger management, domestic violence, or cognitive based. Excludes self-help groups such as Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous and treatment education (i.e. 8-12 education class).

EMPLOYMENT—is defined as the client's employment status on the last day of the month.

- **Employed Full-Time:** The number of clients working an average of 21 hours or more per week during the month.
- **Employed Part-Time:** The number of clients employed for an average of 20 hours or less per week during the month.
NOTE: Multiple part time records do not equal a Full Time status.
- **Not Eligible for Employment:** The number of clients who are not eligible to maintain employment. Include those who are incarcerated pending revocation, in residential treatment, retired, a house parent, disabled, a full-time student, or court exempt.
- **Job Search:** The number of clients not employed and engaged in job search activities.

Pre-Sentence Reports: The number of pre-sentence reports (new crime only) completed and filed with the court this month.

Combination Reports: The number of combination reports (new crime plus probation violation/s) completed and filed with the court this month.

Pre-Disposition Reports: The number of pre-disposition reports (probation violation/s only) completed and filed with the court this month.

 - 5.3.3.1. Residential Treatment
 - 5.3.3.2. With permission
6. IPS total
 - 6.1. This is the sum of the Standard Direct Value and the Standard Indirect Values

7. Administrative

7.1. The number of Standards, IPS, or Unsupervised clients sentenced in a Superior Court for whom Direct or Indirect Supervision is not provided, yet require some case management activity. Include § 13-3601.01 cases sentenced in a Limited Jurisdiction Court.

7.2. Divide into three pulls

7.2.1.1. Will be captured in count if most severe supervision level is that of 'Unsupervised'

7.2.1.2. Include jail with one of the following:

7.2.1.2.3.1. All jail pending revocation is considered direct regardless of the jail location. This includes out of county and out of state.

If open supervision and unsupervised term type, and has an active warrant (Address location of Missing and Reason (qualifier) of Missing Warrant Issued) (with an effective date equal to or less than 90 days old on the last day of the target month – and no other overriding event precludes client from being pulled from MS count, still falls under 'Unsupervised Admin'

7.2.1.9.2. If open supervision and Unsupervised term type, and has an active warrant (Address location of Missing and Reason (qualifier) of Missing Warrant Issued) with an effective date greater than 90 days on the last day of the target month, client shall fall under 'Other Administrative'

7.2.2. Other Administrative

7.2.2.1. Include:

- 7.2.2.1.1. Jail (Regardless of county or state where jail is located)
 - 7.2.2.1.1.1. Any jail will be administrative excluding:
 - 7.2.2.1.1.1.1. Work Furlough

- 7.2.2.1.2. Absconders – Warrant (Standard)
 - 7.2.2.1.2.1. If open supervision and Standard Term type, and has an active warrant (Address location of Missing and Reason (qualifier) of Missing Warrant Issued), with an effective date greater than 90 days on the last day of the target month, client shall fall under ‘Other Administrative’
- 7.2.2.1.3. Absconders – Warrant (Unsupervised)
 - 7.2.2.1.3.1. If open supervision and Unsupervised Term type, and has an active warrant (Address location of Missing and Reason (qualifier) of Missing No Warrant Issued), with an effective date greater than 90 days on the last day of the target month, client shall fall under ‘Other Administrative’
- 7.2.2.1.4. Absconder – Warrant (IPS)
 - 7.2.2.1.4.1. If open supervision and IPS Term type, and has an active warrant (Address location of Missing and Reason (qualifier) of Missing No Warrant Issued), with an effective date greater than 90 days on the last day of the target month, client shall fall under ‘Other Administrative’
- 7.2.2.1.5. Department of Corrections (DOC) Regardless of location
 - 7.2.2.1.5.1. All DOC clients, regardless of county or state will be administrative
- 7.2.2.1.6. Federal Custody (includes pending deportation, if in custody)
- 7.2.2.1.7. Deported

7.2.3. Admin EOM (Total)

- 7.2.3.1. Total Shall include the sum of the ‘Unsupervised’ count and the ‘Other Administrative’ count

8. DCAC/GPS ‘Standard’

8.1. This is the total number of clients on Standard Direct Supervision who are identified as DCAC.

8.1.1. If a client has an open DCAC w/ GPS special attribute at MS run, client will be counted as DCAC for target month and

8.1.1.1. Where the client has been counted for the monthly stats in the target month as ‘Standard Direct’

8.1.1.2. Where the Address location status is ‘Community’ ‘In Community’

8.1.2. If the client does not have DCAC special attribute at first run, client will not be counted for DCAC for target month

9. DCAC/GPS 'IPS'

9.1. This is the total number of clients on IPS Direct Supervision who are identifies as DCAC

9.1.1. If a client has DCAC special attribute at first run client will be counted as DCAC for target month and where

9.1.1.1. Where the client has been counted for monthly stats in the target month as 'IPS Direct'

9.1.1.1.1. Where the Address location status is 'Community' 'In Community'

9.1.1.1.2. Where the Address location status is 'Community' 'In Community'

10. DCAC 'EOM'

10.1. This is the sum of the Standard and IPS values for this category.

Performance Measures:

General Requirements and Rules:

1. *The Add/Mod date will be used and the transactions will “count” in the month in which the data was entered in the APETS Application*

Standard Page 1, Absolute Exits, Other Exits:

An Absolute Exit exists when all cases and counts for a client have been terminated. The exit “counts” for the county with direct supervision when the absolute exit occurs. The following is the hierarchy or priority if multiple termination types are used.

1. Direct Standard Absolute Exits
 - 1.1. Client will count in Absolute exit category for total if:
 - 1.1.1. The client has no open probation case
 - 1.1.1.1. Final Termination of open case(s) within the report period
 - 1.1.1.1.1. Or Final termination from a previous report period that was not captured in any previous report
 - 1.1.1.1.2. The above will change APETS client body status
 - 1.1.1.1.3. APETS will check body status with related reason for absolute exit
 - 1.2. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Revoked to DOC sub category if:
 - 1.2.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for ‘Revoked to Prison’
 - 1.2.1.1. For build change to read ‘Revoked to DOC’
 - 1.3. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Revoked to Jail sub category if:
 - 1.3.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for ‘Revoked to Jail’ and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC
 - 1.4. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Revoked sub category if:
 - 1.4.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for ‘Revoked (Fine)’ and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC or Revoked to Jail.
 - 1.5. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Co-Terminus sub category if:
 - 1.5.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for ‘Co-Terminus’ and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail or Revoked (Fine).
 - 1.6. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Early Termination sub category if:
 - 1.6.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for ‘Early Termination’ and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine) or Co-Terminus.
 - 1.7. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Earned Time Credit (ETC) sub category if:
 - 1.7.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for ‘Earned Time Credit (ETC)’ and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus or Early Termination.

 - 1.8.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for ‘Full Termination’ and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus, Early Termination or Earned Time Credit (ETC).

- 1.9. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Judicial Termination sub category if:
 - 1.9.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Judicial Termination' or "Mental Health Facility" and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus, Early Termination, Earned Time Credit (ETC) or Full Termination.
 - 1.10. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Deceased sub category if:
 - 1.10.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Deceased' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus, Early Termination, Earned Time Credit (ETC), Full Termination or Judicial Termination.
 - 1.11. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Interstate Compact (Incoming) Closed Interest sub category if:
 - 1.11.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Closed Interest' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus, Early Termination, Earned Time Credit (ETC), Full Termination, Judicial Termination or Deceased.
 - 1.11.2. APETS shall display as Closed Interest - ISC
 - 1.12. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Quashed/Purged Warrant sub category if:
 - 1.12.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Quashed/Purged Warrant' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus, Early Termination, Earned Time Credit (ETC), Full Termination, Judicial Termination, Deceased or Interstate Compact (Incoming) Closed Interest.
 - 1.13. Total Number of Direct Absolute Exits
 - 1.14. APETS gets number based on transaction date of event to count for target month. This allows for data not entered in a previous report month, but where the original effective date was in a previous report month. i.e. client was terminated on December 31, but the data was not entered until after the stats were captured for December, this number will count in January count.

 - 2.2. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Revoked to DOC sub category if:
 - 2.2.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Revoked to Prison'
 - 2.2.1.1. For build change to read 'Revoked to DOC'
 - 2.3. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Revoked to Jail sub category if:
 - 2.3.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Revoked to Jail' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC
 - 2.4. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Revoked sub category if:

- 2.4.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Revoked (Fine)' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC or Revoked to Jail.
- 2.5. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Co-Terminus sub category if:
 - 2.5.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Co-Terminus' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail or Revoked (Fine).
- 2.6. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Early Termination sub category if:
 - 2.6.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Early Termination' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine) or Co-Terminus.
- 2.7. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Earned Time Credit (ETC) sub category if:
 - 2.7.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Earned Time Credit (ETC)' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus or Early Termination.

- 2.10. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Deceased sub category if:
 - 2.10.1. One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Deceased' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus, Early Termination, Earned Time Credit (ETC), Full Termination or Judicial Termination.
- 2.11. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Interstate Compact (Incoming) Closed Interest sub category if:

- 2.12. Client will count in Absolute exit category and Quashed/Purged Warrant sub category if:

One or more counts is terminated and termination is for 'Quashed/Purged Warrant' and no other terminated count = Revoked to DOC, Revoked to Jail, Revoked (Fine), Co-Terminus, Early Termination, Earned Time Credit (ETC), Full Termination, Judicial Termination, Deceased or Interstate Compact (Incoming) Closed Interest.
- 2.13. Total Number of Indirect Absolute Exit Clients.
- 2.14. APETS gets number based on transaction date of event to count for target month. This allows for data not entered in a previous report month, but where the original effective date was in a previous report month. i.e. client was terminated on December

31, but the data was not entered until after the stats were captured for December, this number will count in January count.

3.1. This will be the sum of each category's respective total.

3.1.1. Total Number of Direct Revoked to DOC clients combine with the total number of Indirect Revoked to DOC Clients.

3.1.2. Total Number of Direct Revoked to Jail clients combine with the total number of Indirect Revoked to Jail Clients.

3.1.3. Total Number of Direct Revoked clients combine with the total number of Indirect Revoked Clients.

3.1.4. Total Number of Direct Co-Terminus clients combine with the total number of Indirect Co-Terminus Clients.

3.1.5. Total Number of Direct Early Termination clients combine with the total number of Indirect Early Termination Clients.

3.1.6. Total Number of Direct Earned Time Credit (ETC) clients combine with the total number of Indirect Earned Time Credit (ETC) Clients.

3.1.7. Total Number of Direct Full Termination clients combine with the total number of Indirect Full Termination Clients.
