AOC, APSD has adopted practices to give additional supervision credit to some specialty populations for funding and reporting purposes. **Excluding active Warrants that are 90 days or less for Maricopa. Also, with the exception of Maricopa County, credit for dangerous crimes against children wGPS are given against a ratio of 3 to 1 (3:1). Credit for Standard and Intensive Reentry 90 day Pre Release are given against a ratio of 1 to 1 (1:1).
