**Re:** **Automation Expungement Updates: Proposition 207 - Smart and Safe Act**

This is to advise you of the automation changes regarding the expungement portion of the Smart and Safe Act, effective July 12, 2021. Tables for courts maintained by the Administrative Office of the Courts will be updated to reflect the changes. All courts can reference the attached document for detailed automation updates. A general summary is listed below:

- **Event Codes-** adds event codes for petition to expunge and order granting, dismissing or denying.
- **Disposition Code-** adds EX-Expunge Disposition for DPS and MVD reporting (78 code MVD).
- **Disposition Code Overlay-** adds new overlay requirements for EX Disposition Code.
- **Case Type-** adds Expungement case type to process expungement of arrest record or purged record cases.

- **Case Sub Type-** adds Marijuana case sub type to process expungement of arrest record or purged record.

**Additional training information:** An [Expungement Process](#) document is provided to walk users through the new automation updates and general case flow in AJACS.

In addition, please review the [Prop 207: Automation Updates](#) document regarding new title 36 violations and sentencing requirements, effective December 1, 2020. It has been reported that some courts are applying the new Marijuana Civil Penalty, which allocates a hundred percent to the Smart and Safe Fund, to violations other than 36-2853B 1st offense.
