**Re:** **Automation Updates: Proposition 207 - Smart and Safe Act**

This notice is to advise you of the automation changes regarding the Smart and Safe Act with an effective date of December 1, 2020. All automation changes regarding the new expungement process will be communicated at a later date. Tables for AJACS courts maintained by the Administrative Office of the Courts will be updated to reflect the changes. AJIN and NON-AJIN Courts can reference the attached document for detailed automation updates. Below is a general summary:

- **Title 36 Violations** - adds criminal and non-criminal charges to statute table
- **Financial Impact** - adds new agency, event code, receivable code, and allocation breakdown for the civil penalty assessment (*for use on non-criminal violation only*)
- **Penalty Schedule** - standard sentencing applies to all criminal violations
- **Case Subtypes** - added for case and charge tracking purposes

*Note: If case management system does not have a case subtype field, then a new case type may be created in substitution.*

- “Marijuana Non-Criminal” (*LJ courts only*)
- “Special Action Against an Administrative Body” (*GJ courts only*)
