**Subject:** Implementation of Laws 2021, Chapter 189 (SB 1551) and Laws 2018, Chapter 113 (HB 2169)

Dear Administrative Office of the Courts:

The Arizona Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Division (ADOT MVD) is preparing to implement legislative requirements.

Some changes that may impact the courts beginning September 29, 2021, include:

- If the court sends a Disposition Code 55, ADOT MVD will send an Error Code of 022 (Invalid disposition code)
- A Disposition Code 50 will only be accepted if reported on a criminal violation.
- SB 1551 introduces violation of ARS 28-3480C (Operation of vehicle in violation of failure to pay, criminal)
  - Any violation of ARS 28-3480C with a violation date prior to September 29, 2021 will be rejected with an Error Code 100 (Violation code is invalid on this date).
- Updates to the overlay table related to the Disposition Code 58 will be provided in the updated Court Manual.
- For HB 2169, ADOT MVD will reject a Disposition Code of 10-22 with an Error Code 023 (Illegal disposition overlay; this disposition code cannot follow the one currently on file), if the last reported Disposition Code on file is a 58.
- For HB 2169, a Disposition Code 58 received on and after September 29, 2021 will be added to the Motor Vehicle Record with the description of Default of Judgement: Pursuant to ARS 28-1596. Additionally ADOT MVD will update all existing violations with an active Disposition Code 58 that was issued or reported on or after January 1, 2019 to reflect the new definition of Default of Judgement: Pursuant to ARS 28-1596.

ADOT MVD has set aside five test records each for AOC and Phoenix Court. ADOT MVD will provide the test records so that testing may begin on September 23, 2021.
