SUBJECT: HOUSE BILL 2182: IGNITION INTERLOCK EMPLOYER NOTIFICATION

Previously, a person subject to the Certified Ignition Interlock Device (CIID) requirement could operate an employer owned vehicle in the course and scope of the person's employment without a CIID being installed when they carried a completed and signed Ignition Interlock Employer Notification form #96-0242.

Effective September 13, 2013, Laws 2013, Chapter 119, the Ignition Interlock Employer Notification form #96-0242 will no longer be valid due to legislation (House Bill 2182).

A driver required to have an ignition interlock must have the device installed and be in full compliance with all CIID requirements while driving an employer owned vehicle.
