QUALIFIED CASES

- All cases which were in FARE for pre-disposition processing that now have dispositions on all charges and all obligations for payment or appearance have not been satisfied
- Cases, including parking ticket defaults, which meet the criteria for the types of cases that may be sent to FARE in pre-disposition but which have progressed in their case life-cycle such that they are sent to FARE initially with all dispositions, disposition dates and associated financial sentence data and where obligations for payment or appearance have not been satisfied but the case has not been sent to a collection agency. These cases are considered backlog cases

NON-QUALIFIED CASES

- Cases currently at a collection agency
- Civil cases (i.e. small claims, landlord tenant, injunctions against harassment)
- Sealed cases

APPLICABLE FEES

There are no additional fees for cases in post-disposition processing. Cases which have processed through FARE Pre-disposition processing with the FARE General Services Fee added to each charge where the violation date is on or after the Full FARE implementation date, exclusive of parking charges that are cited with other violations on an ATTC, will retain these fees as part of the sentence in Post-disposition. When payment is made, the assessed FARE General Services Fee must be allocated, reported and disbursed as described for all FARE fees in the applicable FARE Administrative Order.
