

COURT PERSONNEL

Appellate and Superior Court Narrative Summary

This summary shows all appellate court, superior court and adult/juvenile probation positions as of June 30, 2009, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey distributed in August 2009.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Supreme Court increased from 428 in FY 2008 to 500 in FY 2009. The majority of this increase was due to the fact the court did not report vacant positions in the FY2008 personnel survey. The FY2009 personnel survey includes vacant positions. Most of the full-time employees in the Supreme Court work for the Administrative Office of the Courts (454 of the 500). Full-time employees in the Court of Appeals (both divisions) decreased by three positions, from 135 in FY 2008 to 132 in FY 2009. Full-time employees in Superior Court (including the clerk's office) decreased from 3,208 to 3,133 this fiscal year, a decrease of 2.3%. Superior Court Probation (comprising adult, juvenile, and combined departments) full-time employees decreased from 4,122 in FY 2008 to 4,022 in FY 2009, a decrease of 2.4%.

The Supreme Court had the services of 1,506 regular volunteers in FY 2009. The Superior Court had the services of 50 regular volunteers, while Superior Court Probation reported 284 regular volunteers. These volunteers include professionals and non-professionals who serve in many different capacities. In the Supreme Court, the regular volunteers are comprised of Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) and members of the Foster Care Review Board (FCRB).

Additionally, the Supreme Court utilized 21,565 hours of temporary personnel assistance while the Superior Court utilized 23,859 hours of temporary personnel assistance. Superior Court Probation utilized 10,958 hours of temporary personnel assistance.

Some of the FY 2008 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report.
