

COURT PERSONNEL

Statewide Narrative Summary

The statewide summary reflects all court positions as of June 30, 2009, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts and probation departments in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey distributed electronically in August 2009.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Arizona judicial system decreased from 9,832 in FY 2008 to 9,684 in FY 2009, a 1.5% decrease. The courts employed an additional 1,046 part-time personnel, up 0.7% from 1,039 in FY 2008.

The most notable increase in full-time personnel appear to be in the position of “Other Court Administrative” (882 to 967). The largest decreases in full-time personnel appears to be in the position of deputy court clerk (2,461 to 2,360) and Field Probation Officer (1,161 to 1,098).

The courts also had the services of 1,928 regular volunteers, a decrease of 4.7% from the 2,024 in FY 2008. Volunteers include attorneys, court reporters, teachers, mediators, information desk personnel, Court Appointed Special Advocates, Foster Care Review Board members, and other professionals and non-professionals who serve as on-call magistrates.

Additionally, the courts utilized 84,462 hours of temporary personnel assistance. This is equivalent to 10,558 person-days, or slightly over 40 full-time employees (at 260 working days per year).

Included in the personnel data were the following full-time and part-time vacant positions: Supreme Court 52 vacant (26 of the vacant positions have been eliminated); Court of Appeals 1 vacant; Superior Court (including the Clerk’s Office) 110 vacant; Probation Departments 585 vacant; Justice Courts 49 vacant; Municipal Courts 78 vacant.

Some of the FY 2008 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Personnel reports received from courts are checked for anomalies, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.
