

COURT PERSONNEL

Statewide Narrative Summary

The statewide summary reflects all court positions as of June 30, 2010, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts and probation departments in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey distributed electronically in August 2010.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Arizona judicial system decreased from 9,684 in FY 2009 to 9,379 in FY 2010, a 3.1% decrease. The courts employed an additional 1,108 part-time personnel, up 5.9% from 1,046 in FY 2009.

The most notable decrease in full-time personnel appear to be in the position of “Other Probation Officer” category (282 to 193). The largest percent decreases in full-time personnel appears to be in the position of “Detention Support Staff” category (48 to 22).

The courts also had the services of 2,249 regular volunteers, an increase of 16.6% from the 1,928 in FY 2009. Volunteers include attorneys, court reporters, teachers, mediators, information desk personnel, Court Appointed Special Advocates, Foster Care Review Board members, and other professionals and non-professionals who serve as on-call magistrates.

Additionally, the courts utilized 107,079 hours of temporary personnel assistance. This is equivalent to 13,385 person-days, or slightly over 51 full-time employees (at 260 working days per year).

Some of the FY 2009 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Personnel reports received from courts are checked for anomalies, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.
