**Appellate and Superior Court**  
**Narrative Summary**  
**Fiscal Year 2019**

The annual personnel summary includes all of Arizona's appellate court, superior court and adult/juvenile probation positions as of June 30, 2019, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts in response to the Supreme Court's electronic distribution of the Fiscal Year 2019 Personnel Survey in June of 2019.

Statewide fiscal year (FY) 2019 personnel statistics for full-time positions, volunteers and temporary personnel are summarized in the following sections.

**Full-time Positions**

Seven justices serve on the Arizona Supreme Court. The total number of full-time funded positions in the Supreme Court decreased by 2 positions, from 504 in FY 2018 to 502 in FY 2019. Almost 90% (89.8%) or 451 of the full-time employees in the Supreme Court work for the Administrative Office of the Courts.

The Arizona Court of Appeals consists of two divisions: Division One, located in Phoenix, is served by 16 judges and Division Two, located in Tucson, is served by six judges. The Court of Appeals' full-time employees decreased from 132 to 130 positions during FY 2019. Of the 130 staff positions, 94 were in Division One and 36 were located in Division Two.

The Superior Court, which has offices in each county, had 180 judges during FY 2019. Full-time employees in the Superior Court (including the clerk's office) decreased from 3,306 to 3,241 this fiscal year, a decrease of 65 positions (2.0%). The Superior Court Probation Department's (including both adult and juvenile departments) full-time employees decreased from 3,645 in FY 2018 to 3,586 in FY 2019 (slightly less than 2%).

**Volunteers**

The Supreme Court and Court of Appeals had the services of 1,971 regular volunteers in FY 2019. The Superior Court had 215 regular volunteers, while Superior Court Probation reported that it had 540 regular volunteers during the same period. These volunteers included professionals and non-professionals who served in many different capacities. The Supreme Court's regular volunteers were comprised of Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) and members of the Foster Care Review Board (FCRB).

**Temporary Personnel Assistance**

The Supreme Court, Superior Court and Superior Court Probation utilized 102,606 hours of temporary personnel labor in FY 2019, the equivalent of 12,826 person days or 49 full-time positions. This was a drop of 13.9% from FY 2018 to FY 2019, 119,164 hours of temporary personnel labor or the equivalent of 57.1 full-time positions in FY 2018.

In FY2019, the Supreme Court utilized 1,886 hours of temporary personnel labor, the equivalent of 236 working days of a .90 full-time position. The Superior Court utilized 38,613 hours of temporary personnel labor, the equivalent of 4,827 person days or 18.5 full-time positions. Superior Court Probation utilized the most temporary personnel labor: 62,107 hours or the equivalent of 7,763 person days or 29.8 full-time employees.

*Note.* Some of the FY 2018 figures may not correspond to figures published in the previous year's data report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the report. Completed personnel surveys received from courts are checked for anomalies but are not audited by the Supreme Court.
