NOTICE OF RETIREE RETURN TO WORK

The CORP Local Board for the Judiciary reviews the reemployment of CORP retirees to determine if action needs to be taken to suspend the retiree's pension. This form must be completed and submitted to the CORP Local Board **by the Superior Court** at the time of hiring or contracting the services of a retired member of CORP.

Disclosure of a member's Social Security number is mandated by Section 6109 of the Internal Revenue Code. The Public Safety Personnel Retirement System uses Social Security numbers only to obtain information about an individual's CORP account and to inform the Internal Revenue Service of distributions and withholdings with respect to the individual's account.

This form is to be completed by the CORP retiree and the Superior Court's payroll or human resources manager.

SECTION 3 – RETIREE AND COURT STATEMENTS OF UNDERSTANDING AND AFFIRMATION

By my signature below, I understand and agree to the following:

If retiree is hired through contracted services: By my signature below, I attest that there is no pre-existing agreement, implicit or explicit, written or verbal, between me and court to which I am now assigned or contracted that I will return to work in the same designated position as an employee of the court to which I am assigned or contracted.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-884.N, a retired member of CORP may become employed by an employer in a designated position and continue to receive a pension if the employment occurs at least 6 months after retirement. The retired member shall not contribute to the fund and shall not accrue credited service. If a retired member becomes employed by an employer in a designated position before 6 months after retirement:

1. Payment of the retired member's pension shall be suspended until the retired member again ceases to be an employee. The amount of pension shall not be changed on account of service as an employee subsequent to retirement.
2. The retired member shall not contribute to the fund and shall not accrue credited service.

The information contained on this form may be shared with another CORP Local Board to ensure compliance with applicable statutes.
