Code	Definition	Criteria
A	Non-CMV Automatic Transmission	Restricted to driving vehicles with an automatic transmission. Assigned when the applicant has the loss of or loss of use of either arm or leg.
B	Corrective Lenses	Restricted to wearing corrective lenses when driving any vehicle. Assigned when the applicant used corrective lenses to pass the Vision Screening or per Vision Examination Report.
C	Mechanical Aid	Full hand controls – Restricted to driving a vehicle equipped with full-hand controls. Assigned when the applicant has the loss of or loss of use of both legs. Mechanical Signals - Restricted to driving vehicles equipped with mechanical signals. Assigned when the applicant has the loss of or loss of use of the left arm.
D	Prosthetic Aid	
E	No Manual Transmission Equipped CMV	CDL ONLY Restricted to driving a CDL vehicle with an automatic transmission only. Assigned when an applicant performs the CDL skills test in a vehicle equipped with an automatic transmission. For the purposes of the skills test and the restriction, an automatic transmission includes any transmission not operating fully on the gear shift and clutch principle.
F	Outside Mirror	Restricted to driving vehicles with an outside left rearview mirror. Assigned by the Medical Review Program.
G	Limit to Daylight Only	Restricted to driving during daylight hours, only. Assigned when the applicant has visual acuity of 20/50 or 20/60 in both eyes or per Vision Examination Report.
H	Limited to Employment	
I	Limited Other	
J	Other	Restrictions not letter coded. Other restrictions are explained in the comment segment (DM3) of the Customer Record. A CID of 013 allows law enforcement to view the restriction comment.
K	Intrastate Only	Restricted to driving a CDL vehicle in intrastate commerce. Assigned when the driver is under the age of 21, or when the driver certifies their medical status as Non-Excepted intrastate.
L	No Air Brakes Equipped CMV	Restricted to driving a CDL vehicle that is not equipped with air brakes. Assigned when the applicant fails the air brake CDL written test or takes the CDL skill test in a vehicle that is not equipped with air brakes.
M	No Class A Passenger Vehicle	Restricted from operating a class “A” bus. Assigned when the applicant performs the CDL skills test in a passenger vehicle requiring a Class “B” CDL
N	No Class A and B Passenger Vehicle	Restricted from operating a class “A” or “B” bus. Assigned when the applicant performs the CDL skills test in a passenger vehicle requiring a Class “C” CDL
O	No Tractor-Trailer CMV	Restricted from operating a truck tractor-semi trailer

P	No Passengers in CMV Bus	Commercial Learner Permit (CLP) Only, Restricted from carrying passengers other than Federal/State auditors and inspectors, test examiners, other trainees, and the CDL holder accompanying the CLP holder
Q	Non- Domicile CDL	Restricted to individuals whose state is decertified by FMCSA, or individuals who do not meet the "Status" requirement as defined in 49 CFR 383.71.
R	Restricted Instruction Permit	Class D only
S	Hearing Aid	
T	Golf Cart Only	Restricted to driving a golf cart, only. Assigned when the applicant completes the road test in a golf cart.
U	None	Restrictions not letter coded. Other restrictions are explained in the comment segment (DM3) of the Customer Record. A CID of 013 allows law enforcement to view the restriction comment.
V	Medical Variance	Assigned when a Variance is issued to a CMV driver either by FMCSA or Arizona Medical Review.
W	Farm Waiver	
X	No Cargo in CMV Tank Vehicle	Commercial Learner Permit (CLP) only, restricted to operating an empty tank vehicle. Assigned when the applicant is issued an "N" endorsement on their CLP.
Y	Instruction Permit	Indicates an instruction permit (IP).
Z	No Full Air Brake Equipped CMV	Restricted to operating a CDL vehicle that operates on a partially airbrake and partially hydraulic brake principle. Assigned when the applicant performs the CDL skills test in an air over hydraulic brake vehicle.
1	Moped/Motorized Cart	Restricted to driving a moped or motorized cart. Assigned when the applicant completes a motorcycle skill test using a moped or motorized cart.
2	Motorcycle 100 cc or less	Restricted to driving a motorcycle with a 100 cc, <b>7 Horse Power (HP)</b> , or less engine. Assigned when the applicant completes a motorcycle skill test using a motorcycle with a 100 cc or less engine
3	Three Wheel Cycle	Restricted to driving an ATV, three-wheel motorcycle or a motorcycle with a sidecar.
4	Right, Left and Inside mirrors	Restricted to driving vehicles equipped with all three mirrors. Assigned when the applicant is unable to turn his/her head, fully.
