It was noted that the amended provisions of ACJA § 7-209(E)(2)(a)(2) would not apply to the initial application because it was submitted prior to the code change; however, concerns were raised that a future renewal application would be evaluated under the amended code provisions. Following discussion, the Committee deferred consideration of the initial application to allow the applicant an opportunity to supplement the application regarding the proposed ABS's future relationship with Arizona, with additional consideration of the regulatory objectives outlined in ACJA § 7-209(E)(2)(a)(1).
