FINAL ORDER

On 03/31/2025, the Board of Nonlawyer Legal Service Providers (“Board”) filed a Notice of Formal Statement of Charges and Right to Hearing in the above-captioned matter [Exhibit A] with the Presiding Disciplinary Judge, the Honorable Lisa Ann VandenBerg (“Judge VandenBerg”). Bonnie Butterworth (“Butterworth”) and Infinity Legal, LLC (“Infinity Legal”) timely filed an Answer to Notice of Formal Statement of Charges and Right to Hearing and requested a hearing. A hearing was held on 07/18/2025. On 07/21/2025, Judge VandenBerg filed the Report and Recommendation in LDP-NFC- 24-L009 and 24-L010.

Under Arizona Code of Judicial Administration (“ACJA”) § 7-201(H)(22)(d), the Board may adopt, reject or modify the Hearing Officer’s recommendation in whole or in part. The Board holds the authority to proceed with this action pursuant to ACJA § 7-201(D)(5)(c).

JURISDICTION

Under ACJA § 7-201(D)(1)(a) the Arizona Supreme Court (“Court”) is responsible for administering the Board of Nonlawyer Legal Service Providers and for adopting rules for the implementation and administration of all certification programs, including minimum qualifications, certification and disciplinary processes and a code of conduct.

Under ACJA § 7-201(D)(5)(c)(1)(g) and ACJA § 7-208(H) the Court’s regulatory boards make all final decisions on the disposition of a complaint.

1 Under ACJA § 7-201(H)(10), the Board served Notice of Formal Statement of Charges
2 and Right to Hearing to Butterworth and Infinity Legal on 03/31/2025. The Board has
3 jurisdiction over this matter as the Butterworth's Legal Document Preparer certificate was
4 granted on 03/26/2018, and Infinity Legal's Legal Document Preparer business entity certificate
5 was granted on November 20, 2023, Certification has been renewed without interruption through
6 the current certification period.

7 Under ACJA § 7-201(H)(6) and ACJA §7-208(H), the matter was investigated, and
8 Butterworth and Infinity Legal were provided an opportunity to respond to the complaint,
9 participate in the investigation of the complaint, file an Answer to the Notice of Formal Statement
10 of Charges, and request a hearing.

11 **PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

12 1. On 07/22/2024, the Certification and Licensing Division ("Division") received a
13 complaint involving Butterworth and Infinity Legal, containing one allegation.

14 2. On 07/29/2024, the Division, via United States Postal Service Certified Mail and via
15 email to a valid point of contact, sent Butterworth and Infinity Legal a copy of the complaint and
16 notice of the ACJA § 7-201(H)(3)(c) requirement that Butterworth and Infinity Legal submit a
17 written response to the complaint within thirty (30) days. Division records confirm delivery of
18 the mailing on 08/13/2024.

19 3. Butterworth and Infinity provided a timely written response to the complaint as required
20 by ACJA § 7-201(H)(3)(c).

21 4. On 01/27/2025, under ACJA § 7-201(H)(5)(a)(3), Probable Cause Evaluator Jeffrey
22 Schrade entered a finding probable cause exists in Allegation 1, as detailed in the Investigation
23 Summary, Determination, Probable Cause Review, and Recommendation Report ("Investigation
24 Summary"), in complaint numbers 24-L009 and 24-L010.

1 4. On 03/31/2025, the Board accepted the finding of the Probable Cause Evaluator and
2 entered a finding for formal disciplinary action as to Allegation 1 under ACJA § 7-201(H)(6)(a).
3 The particular sections of laws, court rules, ACJA, and orders relevant to complaint numbers 24-
4 L009 and 24-L010 are: ACJA §§7-201(F)(1); 7-201(H)(6)(a); 7-201(H)(6)(k)(6), and (8); and
5 ACJA §7-208(J)(1)(a).

6 5. On 06/02/2025, Butterworth and Infinity Legal were served with a Notice of Formal
7 Statement of Charges and Right to Hearing in complaint numbers 24-L009 and 24-L010.
8 Butterworth and Infinity Legal timely requested a hearing and a hearing was held 07/18/2025.

9 6. On 7/18/2025 a hearing was held regarding the Notice of Formal Statement of Charges.

10 7. On 7/21/2025¹ Judge VandenBerg issued a Report and Recommendation [Exhibit B].

11 **FINDINGS OF FACTS**

12 The Board adopts the Findings of Fact in Exhibit B as the Findings of Fact in this matter.

14 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

15 The Board adopts the Conclusions of Law contained in Exhibit B as the Conclusions of
16 Law in this matter. In the Presiding Disciplinary Judge's Report and Recommendations,
17 Conclusion, the Presiding Disciplinary Judge recommended that the Board issue a letter of
18 concern to Bonnie Butterworth. The Report and Recommendation was silent on issuing a Letter
19 of Concern to Infinity Legal, LLC.

20 **FINAL DECISION and ORDER**

21 Having adopted the above-referenced findings and conclusions, the Board orders the
22 following disciplinary sanction in complaint numbers 24-L009 and 24-L010:
