O R D E R

On April 10, 2026, the Committee on Character and Fitness submitted its Findings of Fact and Recommendation for Admission with Conditions as to the application for Jonathan Gregory Lounds for admission to the practice of law.

Pursuant to Rule 36(h)(2), and upon consideration of the Court, en banc,

IT IS ORDERED granting review of the Findings of Fact and Recommendation for Admission with Conditions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED approving the recommendation for admission with conditions except that the Terms of Conditional Admission are modified as follows:

- 1) The term of conditional admission in (I)(A) is extended to 18 months;
- 2) The monthly treatment during the last 6 months in (II)(E) is extended to 12 months, for a total duration of 18 months; and
- 3) The mentoring in (II)(I) is extended to 18 months.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Panel of the Committee forthwith enter the order for conditional admission on the Terms of Conditional

Admission as modified herein.
