O R D E R

The Court en banc has considered the Application for Reinstatement Pursuant to Rule 65 filed by JASON J. KELLER and the Hearing Panel's April 23, 2026 Amended Report and Recommendation and the record transmitted to the Court. Upon consideration, and for the reasons set forth in the Amended Report and Recommendation, the Court concludes that Applicant has not demonstrated by clear and convincing evidence either that he has 1) overcome the presumption against reinstatement under Rule 64(b), or 2) identified just "what weaknesses caused the misconduct and then demonstrate that he has overcome those weaknesses." *In re Arrotta*, 208 Ariz. 509, 513 (2004). Therefore,
