Effective default was entered in this proceeding. An aggravation/mitigation hearing followed. The hearing panel entered a decision and order.

Mr. Andrich appealed that decision and order. On August 31, 2017, the Supreme Court ordered: granting the appeal; affirming the effective entry of default; reversing the order denying the motion of Mr. Andrich to vacate the aggravation/mitigation hearing in this proceeding; vacating the order of restitution; and remanding the matter to the hearing panel for a new mitigation/aggravation mitigation hearing at which Mr. Andrich will be given the opportunity to present evidence on the amount of the restitution. By Order of the PDJ, that hearing was set for October 2, 2017.

On September 8, 2017, the State Bar moved to dismiss the complaint, citing a waste of judicial resources. As dismissal benefits the Respondent, there is no need for response.

Now Therefore,

**IT IS ORDERED** dismissing the complaint without prejudice and vacating all scheduling orders and hearings set.
