O R D E R

Applicant ALAN R. SOLOT has established to the satisfaction of the hearing panel and this Court that his application for reinstatement should be granted. Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that ALAN R. SOLOT is reinstated as an active member of the State Bar of Arizona as of the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the effective date of reinstatement ALAN R. SOLOT shall be placed on probation for a period of two years, under the terms and conditions as listed below:

1. Within thirty days of reinstatement, Applicant must contact the State Bar's Compliance Monitor and schedule a Member Assistance Program (MAP) assessment and enter into a MAP contract with terms including continued mental health therapy with a licensed professional counselor at least once per month, and the licensed professional counselor shall submit quarterly reports to the Compliance Monitor. Such reports shall include information on Applicant's compliance with the recommended course of treatment.

Applicant must comply with all the terms of the MAP contract which shall be incorporated herein by reference. Applicant will be responsible for any costs associated with MAP.

2. Within thirty days of reinstatement, Applicant must contact the State Bar's Compliance Monitor and schedule a Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP) assessment and enter into a LOMAP contract with terms including Applicant's engagement of a practice monitor, and the practice monitor shall submit quarterly reports to the Compliance Monitor. Applicant must resolve his tax debts and comply with any agreed-upon payment schedule with taxing authorities and shall submit monthly reports to the Compliance Monitor regarding the tax debts. The LOMAP contract shall be incorporated herein by reference. Applicant will be responsible for any costs associated with LOMAP.

3. If the tax debts are not resolved within the two-year probation period, probation will automatically renew for subsequent two-year periods until the tax debts are resolved.

4. The State Bar shall report material violations of the terms of probation pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5)(C). A hearing may be held within thirty days to determine if the terms of probation have been violated and if any additional conditions should be imposed.

The burden of proof shall be on the State Bar to prove non-compliance by a preponderance of the evidence.
