**FINAL JUDGMENT AND

On August 7, 2017, the Office of the Presiding Disciplinary Judge (PDJ) sent a notice and a certified copy of the July 17, 2017 Order Approving Stipulation for Discipline issued by the Supreme Court of Oregon to Mr. Williamson's address of record pursuant to Rules 54(h) and 57(b), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

Rule 57(b)(3), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. provides that the PDJ shall impose the identical or substantially similar discipline, unless the respondent can demonstrate an exception by a preponderance of the evidence.

The Supreme Court of Oregon imposed a reprimand. No notice of claim or exception has been filed by either Mr. Williamson or the State Bar asserting that reciprocal discipline is unwarranted.

Now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED imposing the reciprocal discipline of reprimand effective the date of this order pursuant to Rule 57(b)(3), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.
