**FINAL JUDGMENT AND

On March 21, 2018, the Office of the Presiding Disciplinary Judge (PDJ) sent a notice and a certified copy of the February 27, 2018 Order Approving Conditional Admission of Misconduct by the Supreme Court of Colorado to Mr. Donohue's address of record pursuant to Rules 54(h) and 57(b), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

Rule 57(b)(3), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. provides that the PDJ shall impose the identical or substantially similar discipline, unless the respondent can demonstrate an exception by a preponderance of the evidence.

The Supreme Court of Colorado imposed a one year and one day suspension with nine months to be served and the remainder to be stayed upon successful completion of two years of probation. No notice of claim or exception has been filed by either Mr. Donohue or the State Bar asserting that reciprocal discipline is unwarranted.

Now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED imposing the reciprocal discipline of a one year and one day suspension and two years of probation effective the date of this order pursuant to Rule 57(b)(3), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.
