Pursuant to Rule 57, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., the parties filed with the disciplinary clerk a Consent to Disbarment (Consent) dated June 26, 2018. The Consent being compliant with Rule 57(a)(5) and the Presiding Disciplinary Judge having considered it,

Now Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED accepting the Consent and disbaring Respondent, **EUGENE F. O’CONNOR, II, Bar. No 013070**, from the State Bar of Arizona effective immediately. His name is hereby stricken from the roll of lawyers and he is no longer entitled to the rights and privileges of a lawyer but remains subject to the jurisdiction of the court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Mr. O’Connor shall immediately comply with all the requirements of Rule 72, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. which include but are not limited to notification of clients and others and filing all notices and affidavits required.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED under Rule 57(a)(5)(C), no further disciplinary action shall be taken regarding the matters that are the subject of the charges upon which the Consent and this judgment of disbarment are based.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED vacating all ICMC deadlines set forth in this Court's May 15, 2018 Order. In addition, Respondent's pending motion in limine filed May 31, 2018 is deemed moot.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED vacating the Order of Interim Suspension in PDJ 2017-9116.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Mr. O'Connor shall pay the costs and expenses of the State Bar of Arizona, as approved by the PDJ.



I have read and acknowledge that charges have been made against me regarding a felony conviction in the Maricopa County Superior Court criminal case of *State v. Eugene Francis O'Connor*, CR2017-121614-001. I have further

read and acknowledge that the Attorney Discipline Probable Cause Committee has issued a probable cause order regarding these matters on March 23, 2018.

While making no admission of guilt, I state and acknowledge that I do not desire to contest or defend the bar charge, and wish to consent to disbarment.

I have been advised of and have had an opportunity to exercise my right to be represented in this matter by a lawyer. I consent to disbarment freely and voluntarily and not under coercion or intimidation.

I am aware of the rules of the Supreme Court with respect to discipline, disability, resignation and reinstatement, and I understand that any future application by me for admission or reinstatement as a member of the State Bar of Arizona will be treated as an application by a member who has been disbarred for professional misconduct as a result of the bar charge against me bearing the number referenced State Bar Number 17-1827.



COMPLAINT

[State Bar No. 17-1827]

Complaint is made against Respondent as follows:

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

1. At all times relevant, Respondent was a lawyer licensed to practice law in the state of Arizona since May 19, 1990.

COUNT ONE (File No. 17-1827/Arizona)

2. On or about May 6, 2017, the Phoenix Police Department were dispatched to John C. Lincoln Hospital to interview Nancy O'Connor, Respondent's wife.

3. During a day of drinking, Respondent got into an argument with Ms. O'Connor which Respondent escalated into a physical assault.

4. The assault involved Respondent strangling Ms. O'Connor, punching her in the face, striking her in the head and stabbing her in the arm.

5. On September 22, 2017, Respondent was convicted of Aggravated Assault, a Class 3 Felony offense in the Maricopa County Superior Court case of *State v. Eugene Francis O'Connor*, CR 2017-121614.

6. On October 25, 2017, Respondent was sentenced to serve six months in the county jail with an additional deferred jail term of six months effective November 6, 2018.


7. Respondent was also ordered to complete four years of supervised probation including, but not limited to, abstaining from the consumption of alcohol and completion of domestic violence and substance abuse programs.

8. By engaging in the above-referenced conduct, Respondent violated the following ethical rules:

- a. Rule 42, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., ER 8.4(b); and
- b. Rule 54(g), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.





PROBABLE CAUSE ORDER


