FINAL JUDGMENT AND ORDER

On March 30, 2016, the Office of the Presiding Disciplinary Judge sent an amended notice and a certified copy of the Stipulation for Discipline issued by the Supreme Court of Oregon imposing a sixty (60) day suspension stayed pending completion of three (3) years of probation, to Ms. Sheridan's address of record pursuant to Rules 54(h) and 57(b), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

On April 24, 2016, the State Bar filed a Notice of Discipline stating pursuant to Rule 57(b)(3), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., there was no evidence Ms. Sheridan was denied due process, that the evidence was infirm, that grave injustice would occur, or that the sanction is disproportionate in Arizona.

Now therefore, there being no claim of exception filed by Respondent or the State Bar that any exceptions exist,

IT IS ORDERED imposing reciprocal discipline of a sixty (60) day suspension stayed pending completion of three (3) years of probation, retroactive

to August 27, 2015, the effective date of probation in Oregon, pursuant to Rule 57(b)(3).
