The Arizona Code of Judicial Administration (ACJA) § 1-302.E.5 limits “non-facilitated learning” or an individual study program conducted without the aid of an instructor, facilitator, or active co-participants, to eight credit hours toward the annual judicial education requirement.

On January 2, 2013, Administrative Order No. 2013-08 was filed modifying the distribution of credit hours granted for non-facilitated learning. At the request of the Committee on Judicial Education and Training, in order to take advantage of improved eLearning technology and accommodate rural communities with less access to facilitated training, continuation of this increase of allowable non-facilitated learning credit hours is needed.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the limit of 8 credit hours for non-facilitated learning programs that may be used to meet the annual continuing judicial education requirement as described in ACJA § 1-302 be increased to 10 credit hours for calendar year 2014. All other policies, standards, and approval mechanisms described in § 1-302 remain in force.
