Supreme Court of AZ hears two cases in Surprise; public invited to attend

Surprise, AZ (March 10, 2016) – An opportunity to witness the Supreme Court of Arizona in action is coming to Surprise.

On Tuesday, March 29, the public is invited to attend oral arguments at Valley Vista High School's Performing Arts Center, located at 15550 North Parkview Place. Arguments will begin promptly at 9:30 a.m.

This is a rare opportunity to witness the judicial branch of government at work and watch attorneys present real cases to the state's highest court.

Arizona's five Supreme Court Justices believe strongly that this outreach enriches the students' educational experience and gives the community an opportunity to experience the workings of the State's highest appeals court.


The justices have identified [two cases](#) to be presented that day, and attorneys representing each side will be given 20 minutes to present their cases. The justices will take questions from the audience, as long as those questions do not pertain to the case or cases they just heard. The event will end at noon.

Select student groups from public and charter high schools in Surprise have been invited to attend. All guests attending the arguments will need to arrive by no later than **9:00 a.m.** in order to go through security screening. Seating is limited.
