## **Arizona Supreme Court to Hear Arguments in Two Cases at the Sedona Performing Arts Center on April 25**

PHOENIX – The Arizona Supreme Court will be holding arguments in two cases at the Sedona Performing Arts Center on Tuesday, April 25. This is a rare opportunity witness the judicial branch of government at work and watch attorneys present real cases to the state’s highest court.

The justices have identified two cases to be presented and attorneys representing each side will be given 20 minutes to present their arguments. After the second case, the justices will take questions from the audience, as long as those questions do not pertain to the cases they just heard. Details are as follows:
