Mayer Justice Court is now open for business after being evacuated due to the Goodwin Fire. We truly appreciate all the work the first responders and firefighters did to protect the town.

Original Release on June 28, 2017:

### **Court Closure Due To Goodwin Fire**

The Mayer Justice Court is closed due to the mandatory evacuation caused by the Goodwin Fire. It is unknown at this time when the court will reopen. Phone calls are being answered with only general information being provided as we currently do not have access to case information at this time. Judge Rummer and Presiding Judge Mackey are working to determine if an alternative court site can be arranged. If that occurs, further information will be provided.

Hearings scheduled for today, June 28<sup>th</sup>, through the evacuation period and until the court reopens will be reset. Anyone scheduled for a hearing during this time will be notified by mail of the new hearing date.
