Arizona Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument at Northern Arizona University

PHOENIX –Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals, based in Phoenix, in conjunction with Northern Arizona University (NAU), will be holding oral argument followed by a student interaction event, beginning at 10:00AM on Thursday, October 11, 2018, on NAU’s campus in Flagstaff.

This oral argument will be held in Ashurst Hall on NAU’s campus beginning at 10:00AM. The case, *Son Silver, et. al. vs. Sedona et. al.* (CV17-0761), is an appeal arising out of a zoning dispute between the City of Sedona and the Son Silver West Gallery and its owners. Attorneys representing each side of the case will have 20 minutes to present their arguments to the three-judge panel. After the oral argument has been completed, judges from the Court as well as attorneys involved in the case will take questions from the audience, as long as those questions do not pertain to this case.

Starting in 2002, Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals has taken oral arguments on the road to the communities it serves as part of its Connecting with the Community program.

Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals has 16 Judges that hear appeals in panels of three. The Court resolves appeals from eight of Arizona’s Counties, serving more than 5.25 million people and a geographic area larger than about 35 states. In Fiscal Year 2018 (ending June 30, 2018), the Court resolved more than 3,650 cases.
