Attorney and Public Members Needed for State Bar Board of Governors

PHOENIX – A 30-person Board of Governors oversees the policy making and operation of the State Bar of Arizona, the organization that regulates licensed attorneys in Arizona. The State Bar is governed by recently-amended Arizona Supreme Court Rule 32. Applications are being accepted for attorney and non-attorney members to be appointed to the Board.

Because of rule amendments, the makeup of the Board of Governors will reset in 2019 and the Supreme Court will make a total of 10 appointments to the Board. Governors will serve one, two, and three-year terms, depending on their position. The Court will appoint three At-Large Governors, three District Governors, and four Public Members. Another 14 members will join the Board through direct elections.

The Supreme Court is currently accepting applications from attorney members from Maricopa County and from Pima and Santa Cruz Counties for District Governor positions. The Court is also accepting applications from Public and Attorney members from all counties who will serve as At-Large Governors. Applications must be submitted by Noon on Friday, April 12, 2019.
