## Landlord/Tenant Form Available Online

PHOENIX – Governor Doug Ducey’s [Executive Order 2020-14](#), Postponement of Eviction Actions, signed March 24, 2020, directs that enforcement of an eviction order be delayed on a showing that the tenant meets certain requirements that are detailed in the Executive Order.

The Executive Order requires that a tenant provide their landlord documentation showing that they qualify for delaying an eviction. The Arizona Supreme Court developed a form in English and Spanish that includes the situations stated in the Executive Order. A tenant may use this form as part of the notification process to the landlord. Tenants do not need to use the Court’s form, but it is available to go with the additional information tenants need to provide landlords under the Executive Order. Tenants are encouraged to keep copies of the information they provide to their landlords. The information may be needed in court or to show to the officials who enforce eviction orders.
