Judge Louis Frank Dominguez Earns State Bar Public Lawyer Award

PHOENIX – Surprise City Court Presiding Judge Louis Frank Dominguez has been recognized for the Michael D. Ryan Award for Judicial Excellence by the Public Lawyers Section of the State Bar of Arizona. The Award was named in honor of former Arizona Supreme Court Associate Justice Michael D. Ryan. Judge Dominguez’s award acknowledges his decades of contributions to Arizona’s judicial branch, to the State Bar of Arizona, to his local community, and to statewide education efforts.

Judge Dominguez has practiced law in Arizona for nearly 40 years, 26 of those as a judge. The long list of accomplishments Judge Dominguez was recognized for included service on numerous committees, speaking engagements at seminars and other educational opportunities, and for his service on the Arizona Commission on Judicial Conduct. Judge Dominguez has led education sessions on Judicial Ethics, Human Relations and Diversity, Jury Trials, Judicial Demeanor, Criminal Law Practice and Procedure, Sentencing, Appeals, Victims’ Rights, and Case Management for the Arizona Supreme Court, the Arizona State Bar, The National College on Judicial Conduct and Ethics, the American Bar Association, and other organizations.

Judge Dominguez’s prior recognitions include a “Distinguished Leadership Award” from the National Association of Community Leadership, a “Distinguished Service Award” from the Arizona Supreme Court, and a Trainer Excellence Award.
