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Initial Phase of Statewide *eAccess* Public Records Portal is Complete

PHOENIX – The Arizona Supreme Court is pleased to announce public, electronic, remote access to millions of superior court case records and data through the *eAccess* online portal. With the recent addition of Pima County Superior Court case records and data, *eAccess* now offers online access to select civil and criminal case data and documents from the superior court in all of Arizona’s fifteen counties.

Initial implementation of *eAccess* includes:

- Civil cases of the Superior Court filed on or after July 1, 2010
- Criminal cases of the Superior Court filed on or after July 1, 2010
- Pima County Superior Court criminal cases filed on or after July 1, 2015
- Ability to electronically certify documents
- Ability to electronically verify the authenticity of a certified document

eAccess provides convenient online access to case data and documents 24 hours a day, seven days a week for the public, attorneys, government users, the media, and litigants. Access to view, save, and print court documents is through a monthly paid subscription or by paying on a document-by-document basis. The records available through *eAccess* will still be available directly through the court or clerk’s office where the case is assigned. Public court records that are not available through *eAccess* will remain available from the court or clerk’s office where the case is assigned.
