O R D E R

The Court, by a panel consisting of Vice Chief Justice Timmer, Justice Bolick, Justice Lopez, and Justice Beene, has considered the briefs of the parties, the record, the trial court's ruling, and the relevant statutes and case law in this expedited election matter.

The Court finds that the complaint complied with the statutory requirements under A.R.S. § 16-351(A). The complaint and its exhibit specified the petition number, line number and basis for the challenge for each signature. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED affirming the trial court decision denying the Motion to Dismiss.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED affirming the trial court decision granting the requested injunction prohibiting Mariana Sandoval's name from being printed on the ballot for the November 2020 General Election as a candidate for the office of Governing Board Member of Avondale Elementary School District #44.
