ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL AND CROSS-APPEAL

Plaintiffs/Appellants Barbara LaWall, et al. ("Challengers") appealed the superior court's order in Maricopa County Superior Court No. CV2020-008289 denying their request to enjoin the "Second Chances Rehabilitation and Public Safety Act" ballot initiative, I-32-2020, sponsored by the Arizonans for Second Chances, Rehabilitation, and Public Safety committee.

Plaintiff/Appellant Arizonans for Second Chances, Rehabilitation, and Public Safety committee, et al. ("Proponent") filed a cross-appeal challenging the superior court's order in Maricopa County Superior Court No. CV2020-008709 denying Proponent's request to reinstate certain signatures.

On August 20, 2020, Challenger filed a second notice of supplemental authority and provided an "Updated Final Certification" dated August 20, 2020 from the Arizona Secretary of State that states, "I-32-2020 has not submitted a sufficient number of signatures for placement on the November 3, 2020 ballot."

On August 21, 2020, Proponent filed a motion to dismiss the cross-appeal.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED granting Proponent's motion to dismiss the cross-appeal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED dismissing as moot Challenger's appeal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED denying the parties' requests for attorneys' fees.
