O R D E R

Applicant GARETH C. HYNDMAN II has established to the satisfaction of the Hearing Panel and this Court that his application for reinstatement should be granted. Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that GARETH C. HYNDMAN II is reinstated as an active member of the State Bar of Arizona effective the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the effective date of reinstatement GARETH C. HYNDMAN II shall be placed on probation for a period of two years, under the terms and conditions as listed below:

1. Within thirty days of reinstatement, Applicant shall contact the State Bar's Member Assistance Program (MAP) and submit to an assessment. Applicant shall thereafter enter into a MAP contract based on the recommendations made by the MAP director or designee. Applicant shall comply with all the terms of the MAP contract which shall be incorporated herein by reference. Applicant shall be responsible for any costs associated with MAP.

2. In the event Applicant returns to the practice of law in Arizona, he shall immediately notify the State Bar's Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP) and enter into a LOMAP contract based on the recommendations of the LOMAP director or designee. The terms shall include the restriction that Applicant may not practice as a solo practitioner.

3. The State Bar shall report material violations of the terms of probation pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., and a hearing may be held within thirty days to determine if the terms of probation have been violated and if an additional sanction should be

imposed. The burden of proof shall be on the State Bar to prove non-compliance by a preponderance of the evidence.
