O R D E R

Applicant Christy C. Brown has established to the satisfaction of the hearing panel and this Court that her application for reinstatement should be granted. Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that Christy C. Brown is reinstated as an active member of the State Bar of Arizona as of the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the effective date of reinstatement Christy C. Brown shall be placed on probation for a period of two years, under terms and conditions listed below:

1. Within ten (10) days of reinstatement, Applicant must contact the State Bar Compliance Monitor. Applicant will enter into a Member Assistance Program (MAP) contract with terms including the following: Applicant will be required to submit to her choice of either a full five-panel random UA testing or a full five-panel hair follicle analysis; Applicant will be required to engage in relapse counseling with either Hal Nevitt or another licensed substance abuse counselor at a frequency determined by the substance abuse counselor; and Applicant will be required to continue treating with her psychiatrist and take all medication prescribed by her treating psychiatrist. Applicant will be responsible for any costs associated with MAP.

2. The State Bar shall report material violations of the terms of probation pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5)(C). A hearing may be held within thirty days to determine if the terms of probation have been violated and if any additional conditions should be imposed. The
